IV. Title I Evaluation Document:	<p>Mr. Nguyen presented on the Title I Evaluation Document to the school site council. The document outlines strategies implemented by the Anaheim Union High School District's South Junior High to enhance college, career, and life readiness among students. Successful initiatives include professional development for teachers, such as monthly support from a 5Cs coach, while challenges include declines in academic progress despite comprehensive support. 	<p>The South Junior High Uniform Policy for 2024-2025 permits students to wear a range of shirts including school uniform polo shirts, college shirts, and school spirit/club shirts, as well as pants, shorts, and skirts of any color, provided they meet specific criteria such as appropriate length and absence of holes. Additionally, students are required to wear their student IDs at all times as part of the uniform and adhere to dress code expectations regarding size appropriateness and restrictions on certain items like sweatpants and pet-type choker chains. Feedback from the School Site Council suggests a desire for more variety and colorful options in the uniform to allow for self-expression, while parents and teachers advocate for alternative means of self-expression to prevent the uniform policy from becoming ineffective due to students dressing inappropriately.</p>
